

Report on the timetable for consideration of the Abolition of the Right to Buy and Associated Rights (Wales) Bill

March 2017

On 13 March 2017, a Government Bill, the Abolition of the Right to Buy and Associated Rights (Wales) Bill, was introduced in the Assembly.

On 14 February 2017, the Business Committee agreed, in accordance with Standing Order 26.9, to refer the Bill to the Equality, Local Government and Communities Committee to consider and report on the general principles.

On 7 March 2017, the Business Committee agreed, in accordance with Standing Order 26.7, a timetable for the Committee's consideration of the general principles of the Bill and agreed that the Committee should report to the Assembly by 7 July 2017.

The Business Committee also agreed that Stage 2 proceedings should be completed by 13 October 2017, subject to the general principles of the Bill being agreed by the Assembly.
