

Revised timetable for consideration of the Public Services Ombudsman (Wales) Bill

November 2018

On 2 October 2017, a Committee Bill, the Public Services Ombudsman (Wales) Bill, was introduced in the Assembly.

On 19 September 2017, the Business Committee agreed, in accordance with Standing Order 26.9, to refer the Bill to the Equality, Local Government and Communities Committee to consider and report on the general principles.

On 19 September 2017, the Business Committee agreed, in accordance with Standing Order 26.7, a timetable for the Committee's consideration of the general principles of the Bill and agreed that the Committee should report to the Assembly by 9 March 2018.

The Business Committee also agreed that Stage 2 proceedings should be completed by 18 May 2018, subject to the general principles of the Bill being agreed by the Assembly.

At their meeting of 13 November 2018 Business Managers agreed to a request from the Chair of the Finance Committee that the Stage 2 reporting deadline be extended to 8 February 2019, following the agreement of the financial resolution on 17 July 2018.
