Request for Information.

Thank you for your request received on 27 April in which you asked:

- 1. Will "Dippy" the Diplodocus be coming to the Senedd during it's tour of the UK?
- 2. If so, how long for, and what is the cost to the Assembly for this?
- 3. If not, has any cost been incurred by the Assembly in relation to this?

We have answered your questions below.

- 1. "Dippy" the Diplodocus will not be coming to the Senedd during its tour of the UK but will be at the National Museum Cardiff between 19 October 2019 and 26 January 2020.
- 2. Not applicable.
- 3. An event was held at the Natural History Museum to launch 'Dippy' going on tour. This event was attended by two Assembly Commission staff. The only costs incurred were travel and accommodation costs, totalling £350.75. Whilst in London, they took the opportunity to visit their counterparts in Westminster to discuss amongst other things the Suffragettes: 100 years of votes for women.
