- 4. Please provide details of any speeding/parking fines/fixed penalty notices that Janet Finch-Saunders has declared since her tenure as Assembly Member.
- 5. What has Janet Finch-Saunders declared as her total annual income?
- 1. How many domestic properties has Janet Finch-Saunders declared that she owns or has an interest in?

Section 36(7)(a) of the Government of Wales makes it an offence for any Member to participate in proceedings of the Assembly without having registered a relevant interest as specified in the Annex to Standing Order 2.

The Record of Proceedings is a substantially verbatim transcript of the proceedings of the National Assembly's Plenary meetings.
