Please can I request the following information under the FOI act:

- I. annual total spend on office refurbishment in Tŷ Hywel (each of the last three financial years, plus year to date)*
- II. annual spend on building maintenance (each of the last three financial years, plus year to date)*

The information you have requested is provided below.

Building maintenance is for the entire estate – Tŷ Hywel, Senedd and Pierhead and includes planned preventative maintenance to ensure compliance with statutory requirements and ensuring continued operation of plant and equipment as well as reactive maintenance in response to breakdowns and repairs to include heating and cooling, mechanical and electrical, lifts, security and catering equipment and fabric maintenance.
