- 3. Who is responsible for managing the travel policy and sustainability objectives for your institution

Please find our responses to your questions below.

- 1. 43,920 miles have been travelled by employees using their own cars between September 2016 and August 2017.
- 2. £19,908 have been reimbursed to employees for those journeys between September 2016 and August 2017.
- 3. The <u>Assembly Commission</u> has overall responsibility for the travel policy of the organisation. The Estates & Facilities service within the National Assembly for Wales has a sustainability team who are responsible for managing the sustainability objectives.
