Dear Mike,

I am writing in response to the question you raised in plenary on 17 September regarding accidents on the M4 between junctions 45 and 47.

The police are currently undertaking their investigations into the two recent collisions on this section of the M4 and officials await the official police reports. However, no feedback has been received to date to suggest that the condition of the highway at either location was a contributory factor in either collision.

Once we have received the information from the police, we will take any issues forward and develop an appropriate scheme if required. In the meantime the M4 will be subject to inspection and maintenance in accordance with the Welsh Government Trunk Road Maintenance Manual and the design standards.
